


**GRADE 5 SUPPLY LIST**

Dear Parents,

In Grade 5 **all work is to be done in pencil**. Students will only be using pens when correcting work or doing special assignments. It is also expected that students in Grade 5 are able to keep their shoes tied at all times. Students who do not know how to tie their shoes will have to attend shoe tying lessons with Mr. Zach at recess every day until they have learned. **Please label all supplies with your child's name and class**. Some supplies may need to be replenished.

- 8cm 2 Ring Binder - Package of dividers	All documents in Grade 5 are made with 2 holes. <u>Please do not buy binders with more than two rings.</u>	2 Binders 2 Packages of dividers
- HB Pencils - Erasers	Students <b>must</b> have a pencil to use in class every day. They can be normal or mechanical. Erasable ink <b>pens are not</b> acceptable.	12 Pencils 2 Erasers
- Package of coloured pencils (pencil crayons)	Many assignments will require students to colour. Markers are optional, but they must have coloured pencils.	1
- Pens (red, blue, black)	Students will use pens when correcting work. They will not do any regular classwork in pen.	1 of each colour
- Highlighters	A useful study tool.	2
- Pencil Sharpener (small, not the crank style)	A small sharpener that can fit inside of a pencil case. It must be able to hold the pencil shavings.	1
- Pencil case	Should fit in the desk.	1
- 30 cm clear plastic ruler: <b>Do not</b> buy a "jelly ruler" that bends. Students play with them and they are not accurate after being bent so much.		1
