

Dear Grade 2 Parents,

The conferences on Thursday, March 15th, 2018 are a celebration of your child's learning. It is not a time to sit down one-on-one with the teacher. These are Student-Led Conferences. As the name suggests students will take you around 5 stations (Reading, Writing, Science, Math and Social Studies) to show off what we have been learning about over the last term. If a more intensive meeting is required, it can be set up for another time.

The reading station and writing stations will be located in Ms. Aislinn's class (210). The Math and Social Studies stations will be located in Ms. Margaret's class (211). The Science station will be located in the hallway outside the grade 2 classes. Portfolios will be available to take home to go through with your child over the weekend.

Remember, your child has worked hard to prepare for this day and they may be nervous. We will be practicing the stations the week beforehand, but in case your child forgets, there will be instruction cards; feel free to help them by reading it and prompting them with questions.
